

## THE PLAYHOUSE PLAY KIT PROJECT

## Goals

- Mitigate trauma caused by the Pandemic
- Stay connected to families in the community
- Design open-ended, engrossing activities that support development
- Provide an accurate and reassuring child development message
- Support parents

## Activities and Preliminary Numbers from May to October 2020

- 5 Play Kits for ages 2-6: Playhouse Care Package, Everybody Let's Go Outside, Water and Wondering, Pizza and More, and the Autumn Kit. Each kit has over 10 activities.
- **4 STEAM Kits for ages 6 and up**: Town Engineer, Artistic Chemist, Art in Motion, and Let's Explore Light.
- 1 Infant/Toddler Kit for ages 9 to 24 months
- 1000 total kits distributed.
- **36% of families made "pay what you can" donations** ranging from \$10-\$20 to cover the cost of materials.
- 64% were distributed free of charge to families in financial distress via The Playhouse and area agencies such the Hunger Coalition, the preschool early intervention program of Watauga County schools, the Department of Social Services foster care program, and the Children's Council.
- **Spanish activity guides** were made available and promoted through local aid groups and the schools.
